Atka

Near Term Goals/Priroites-2017-2022

- Clinic replacement in the next 1-2 years
- Day care building improvements in the next 1-2 years
- Atka Pride Seafoods expansion in next 2-3 years
- Improved Broadband for education, telemedicine, job training, business development, and entertainment in next 2-3 years

Middle Term Goals/Priorities – 2023-2025

- Atka Store expansion in next 3-5 years
- Additional and replacement housing in next 3-5 years
- Korovin and Chuniixsax Road upgrade in next 3-5 years

Long Term Goals/Priorities – 2026-2030+

- Harbor Construction/Upgrade in next 5-6 years
- Water Dam Replacement in next 5-10 years
- FEMA Shelter Construction in next 5-10 years
- Community Center and Snack Shop in next 5-10 years
 - Hydroponics System to provide fresher and less costly produce in next 5-10 years
- Community Baanax (steam bath) in next 5-10 years
- Heavy Equipment for Community Projects in next 5-10 years
- Church Maintenance and Repairs to include Grave Identification Project in next 5-10 years

Economic Development Priorities

Near Term Goals/Priroites-2017-2022

- Renewable energy project to replace diesel generation in next 3-5 years
- Replace Water Supply Lines, main and home- **Complete with APICDA CDGP 2019**
- Replace powerlines and electric distribution system in next3-5 years
- **Improve access to Broadband for education, telemedicine, job training, business development, and entertainment in next 2-3 years**
- Replace aging heavy equipment in next 3-5 years
- Improve road maintenance in next 3-5 years

Middle Term Goals/Priorities – 2023-2025

- Erect building to protect heavy equipment, tools, and other materials from salt spray and inclement weather – 3 to 5 years
- Construct new roads/trails to heavily used subsistence and recreational areas – 3 to 5 years
- Construct sturdier bridges and replace existing culverts – 3 to 5 years
- Replace/add fire hydrants fire improved fire response – 3 to 5 years

Long Term Goals/Priorities – 2026-2030+

- Build more cabins for recreational and subsistence use in 5 -10 years

- Identify property and roads in danger of erosion from storms and rising sea levels and develop strategies to mitigate damage
- Agricultural Soil Analysis to determine viability for small scale agriculture
- Wildflower seeds project for kids

- Modest population growth
