Samson Owned Facility, 2.8 acres adjacent to the City Dock





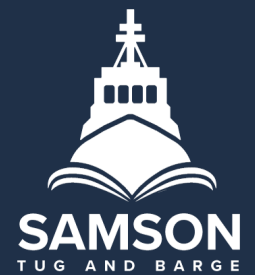
# Kodiak Terminals

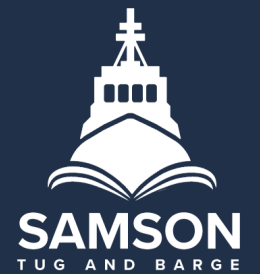

USCG Dock 346' - APL dock

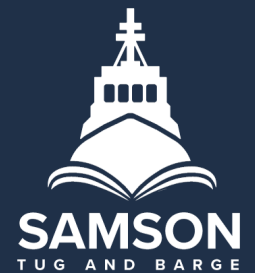
City dock - Spit dock 375'

Over 5 ½ acres on the waterfront available including a 300' dock. Samson warehouse space available.

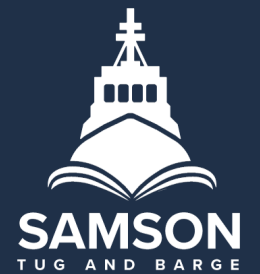

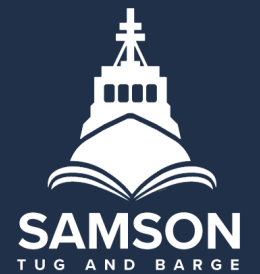

Samson operated facility adjacent to the Metlakatla Dock



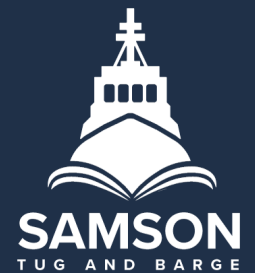

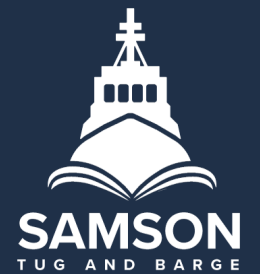

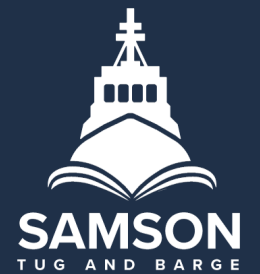
